	The project aims at developing basic speaking, writing and reading language skills in Bulgarian. The targt group is represented by immigrants from Afghanistan, Belarus, India, Ukraine, Kazakhstan, Russia, Moldova, China, Korea, etc. The project develops practical knowledge of the language and its use in real-life situations. In addition, the immigrants are introduced to important moments in Bulgaria's history, its official symbols as well as emblematic elements and their symbolism such as the Bulgarian rose, the Thracian and medieval cultural heritage, national holidays and traditions, etc. The language teaching approach is set on speaking situations from everyday life, the communication with the administrative system in Bulgaria as well as specific lexical forms. The language course includes exams and tests for testing acquired knowledge.
	The learners include people with absolutely no knowledge in Bulgarian as well as people with very basic knowledge.
	During the courses the immigrants have the chance to exchange
	information about their own countries, traditions, recipes, etc.
