

TRAINING WORKSHOPS AND LANGUAGE COURSES

IN SPAIN

Six training workshops (20 hours) were held in IFES-Valencia, Spain, on the following dates: 2nd and 16th of April; 7th, 22nd and 23rd of May (2014), for 36 participants (representatives of migrant organisations, healthcare and language providers). 12 migrant associations from 10 different countries took part in the workshops. The participants were introduced to the project and its outcomes, and got the communication and social skills needed for managing multicultural groups in order to help migrants with background information on healthcare matters in Spain. They also learned techniques for working in adult education.

Three short language courses (10 hours) were held in IFES-Valencia, Spain, on the following dates: 2nd and 16th of April; 22nd of May (2014), for 30 participants (representatives of migrant organisations and language providers). 12 migrant associations from 10 different countries took part in the courses. They acquired language skills, social competences and knowledge about the healthcare system and services in Spain for better integration into society. There will be more courses due to the willingness of participants to spread the project materials among their local communities.
