The website is available in four languages: Spanish, French, Romanian and English. <b>Description</b>	<p><b>What type of products/ resources?</b> <b>Online resources</b></p> <p>The Resource Center for Information, Education and Communication in Health for Migrant Population is a useful space for the exercise of public health and health care adapted to the new multicultural reality of our society.</p> <p>The Ministry of Health of the Spanish Government, which funds the center, and the Departments of Health of the Autonomous Communities are making important efforts to properly manage its activities and programs for immigrants residing in Spain. Many NGOs and scientific societies have also developed multiple culturally adapted informative and divulgative resources. On the other hand</p>

	<p>the Ministries of Health and other NGOs and government organizations in the countries of origin of our migrant population, as well as international cooperation projects operating, edit information, education and communication resources already adapted.</p> <p>The aim of the EASP, as generator of this initiative is to collect these materials via the WWW, putting them directly and immediately available to anyone interested in working within the health system or in promoting it and thus support both work of individual attention and group actions. As an additional cooperation objective, the Center maintains contacts with the departments of education and health promotion of the Ministries of Health of the countries of origin of the migrant population, to invite them to participate in the process of cultural adaptation and to let them use these materials generated in other environments and interesting for their population.</p>
