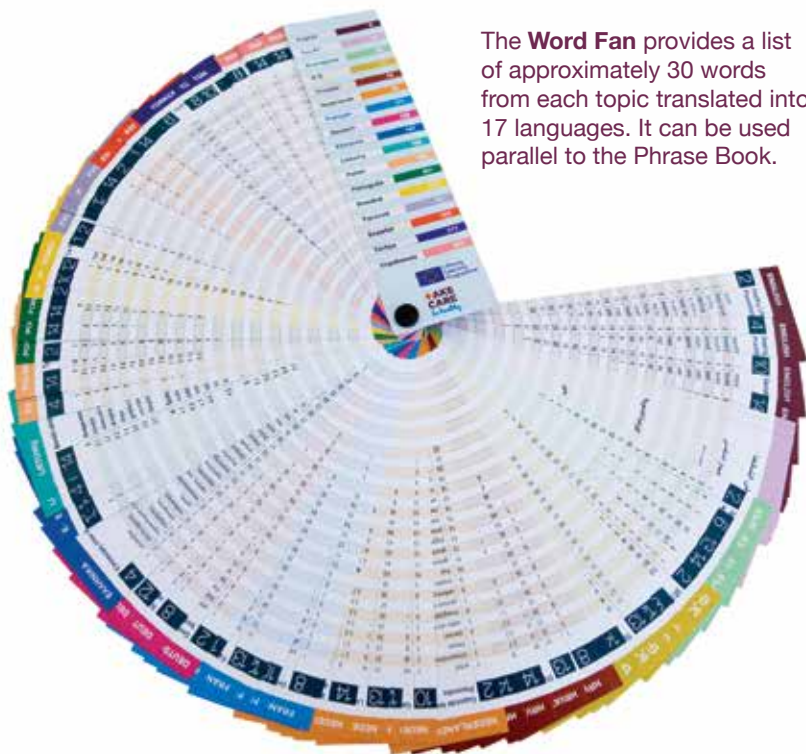


# The Healthcare Language Guide



The **Word Fan** provides a list of approximately 30 words from each topic translated into 17 languages. It can be used parallel to the Phrase Book.

The Healthcare Language Guide for Migrants is the main product of Take Care Project. The project has the goal to help migrants gain new language skills related to healthcare matters, improve the communication between healthcare providers and patients and give information about the healthcare system in the partner countries. Partners from 8 European countries cooperate closely with organisations supporting migrants' integration and welfare, educational institutions and health care providers to create a European-wide network during the project lifetime: November 2012 - October 2014.

# The Healthcare Language Guide

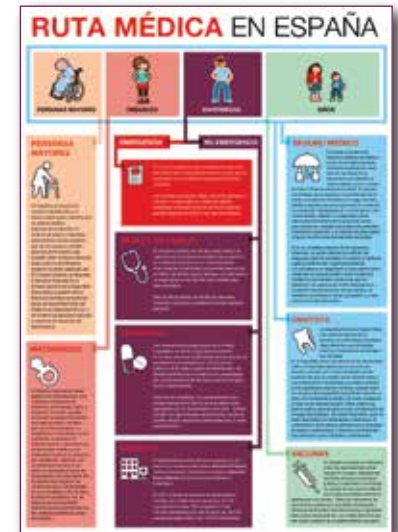
