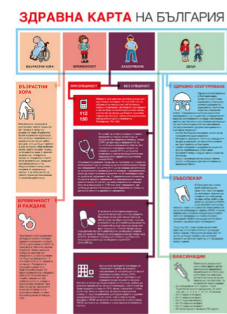
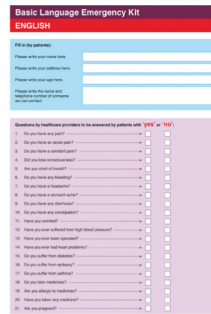
- *How do you help migrants gain new language skills on healthcare matters?*
